Wireless House Alarm System



With its ability to call you and send a text message there is no need to pay for expensive monitoring

The Premier alarm system from You Protect is both affordable and simple to operate.

Upon activation the Premier will call up to 6 phone numbers, repeating up to 3 times, until the call is answered. It can also send a text message to a further 3 numbers.

This clever feature means you are immediately notified of an intrusion and removes the need to pay for expensive monthly monitoring and long contracts from an alarm company.

The PIR sensor measures subtle changes in room temperature sending a

signal to the control panel upon detection.

The Door/Window sensor comes in two parts. One part is attached to the door and another to the frame. As the door is opened the sensor is triggered.

Remote Control Key fobs allow you to quickly arm or disarm the Premier at the touch of a button. They also have a panic button that can be pressed to cause immediate activation in an emergency.

The very loud, 110 decibel internal siren can be wired to the Control Panel if required and will immediately deter intruders on activation.

Sensors connect to the main control panel using advanced wireless technology so there is no need to trail cables around your house.

The Premier is ready to use out-of-the-box with all sensors pre-programmed. A Pay-As-You-Go Mobile Phone SIM card (available separately or provided by you) must be inserted for the system to make calls and send text messages.

The Premier can be located anywhere there's a standard mains power supply and it contains a battery backup should power fail or be interrupted.

1 x Internal Siren
1 x Enhanced PIR Room Sensor
1 x Door/Window Contact Sensor
2 x Deluxe Remote Control Keyfobs



Other Features:

Zones - 99 wireless, 9 wired

Every wireless sensor has to be linked to a zone. Each zone has a name so when the system activates you know which area in your home is affected. The Premier Protect has 8 pre-defined names that can be associated to any zone; SOS, Fire, Gas, Door, Hall, Window, Balcony and Boundary.

Zone Types

Each Zone has a Type to determine how it should respond when a sensor linked to the zone is activated:

1. Real-time: If armed the alarm will trigger immediately.
2. 40 secs delay: If armed the alarm will trigger after this time. This can be useful on entry/exit doors.
3. 24 hrs: The alarm will trigger immediately regardless of whether or not it is armed. This type is used for Panic Buttons, Smoke & Gas detectors so they always work.
4. Bypass: Used to temporarily isolate a zone/detector from the system. Great for when pets are left at home. The alarm will not trigger.

Home Zones

Any Zone can be configured as a Home Zone that will either alarm or not. This is very useful at night when you would want door/window sensors on the perimeter of your house to be active but not internal room sensors. This way you can get up during the night and not trigger the alarm, yet still be protected.

Armed States

These determine to what level the alarm is armed. The alarm will trigger in accordance with its Zone Type. The armed state can be set from the Control Panel, Remote Key Fob or via a telephone by calling the alarm and pressing numbers on the phone's keypad.

1. Full Arm: Any sensor that activates will trigger the alarm. Maximum protection.
2. Home Arm: Only sensors linked to a Zone defined as a Home Zone will trigger the alarm.

Timed Arm/Disarm

It is possible to set the alarm to automatically arm or disarm at 3 different times every day.

Emergency Calls & Panic Button

The Premier Protect has a built in microphone and speaker so you can use it like a normal telephone or two-way intercom to monitor what is happening in the home. The Remote Key Fob also has a Panic Button that can be activated to trigger the alarm immediately.

Voice announcements and message recording

During programming the alarm provides helpful voice prompts. It is also possible to record your own message that will be played to those who receive a call from the alarm.

Power fail alert

Should the alarm lose its mains power it can send a text message to warn you.

Signal Check

The Premier II can give an accurate indication of the signal strength in your area, giving you peace of mind on the coverage of your chosen mobile phone network.

For more details on this or any of our products please see our website. All our products are covered by a warranty for a minimum period of 12 months. If they fail during this time we will either repair or replace the product free of charge. This does not apply to consumables such as batteries. The Premier II needs a SIM card to work and you must maintain a credit balance with the mobile network operator for the alarm to function properly. Some mobile network operators will deactivate your number if it's not used within 3 months. We strongly advise that you test your alarm or place a call once a month to ensure that this does not happen. Please read all the instructions that come with your alarm carefully. Failure to position sensors as described may mean they do not detect properly or could result in false activations. We are not responsible in any way for any failure of the alarm to activate or for failures within the mobile network. Any distances quoted for wireless products are the maximum they will work over. In practice the distance can be considerably less due to the conditions in which they are placed. You should treat your alarm PIN code and phone number in the same way as you would your Bank Card PIN number. For security reasons we do not keep records of your PIN number so look after it! **You must not under any circumstances program the Premier to automatically call the emergency services as they will not respond.**
